Tucked beneath the mother-of-pearl dial, circled by a diamond-set bezel, is a self-winding mechanical movement with a 40-hour power reserve. With this limited edition of 60, Blancpain confirms, were it ever necessary, that a jewel-watch remains first and foremost a watch.
